How Band Member Opinions will be Collected, Counted and Verified:

Who to Talk to: Three people knowledgeable of the project are named as contact people in the Notice of Intent and in the Wind Farm Information Package, so there is always someone to find if a person wants to talk.

## **Confidentiality and Methods:**

Each of the named individuals has signed an affidavit attesting to maintaining confidentiality and the methods stated herein used to collect supporting and opposing views.

Name and Opinion Collecting and Recording: The name and opinion of each person and how they express their opinion will be noted whether in person or by; phone, email, fax or regular mail. Any method is acceptable.

**Online Form:** In addition, a form is available online (Wind Farm Opinion Form) for convenience.

## **Check for Double Counting:**

Once each of the named individuals completes their list of names and opinions the names will be cross-checked so no one is double counted and compiled into one master list.

**Verification:** This final list will be reviewed by an independent professional to verify the count of those in favour and those opposed to the Wind Farm and to verify that each individual is a Member on the Band Registry.

The Wind Farm Information Package: Scheduled for release on and off reserve before the end of December, 2008.

## **Opinions Accepted Any Time:**

Members can offer their opinions once they have had a chance to review the Wind Farm Information Package, or at any time prior if they are already in favour of such a development and/or have had personal conversations with the individuals named in the Notice of Intent.
