#### 1. Restricted Access (Roadblocks) Pickerel R Rd. and Bekanon Rd.

Members with spouses that may be nonmembers of HIFN are allowed into the community, however when these visits occur, we expect no unnecessary contact with on-reserve members.

#### 2. Food Distribution

#### 3. Re-Opening the Administration
